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Sub: Public Auction of two numbers of adult cows (Jersey cross and Murrah Buffalo) for meat purpose at ICAR Nagaland Centre, Medziphema on 31.08.2021 (Tuesday) at 9:30 am

Sir,

I, AAO, on behalf of the Joint Director, ICAR RC for NEH Region, Nagaland Centre, Medziphema states the terms and conditions for public auction of cows as under:

Terms & Conditions for auction of cows:

1.The details of the pigs for auction are as under:

Sl. No.	Particulars	Body weight (approx in kgs)	Book value (Rs)
1	Jersey cross cow (Laxmi)	260	140/kg
2	Murrah Buffalo cow (MB-3)	240	

2. The public auction will be held at ICAR-RC for NEH Region, Nagaland Centre, Medziphema on 31.08.2021 at 9:30 am onwards.

3. Sale of cows is only for meat purpose as these cows are not suitable for future breeding.

4. All interested parties are requested to attend the auction on the above specified place and time. The party quoting the highest rate shall be awarded the auction sale.

5. During auction process, acceptance or rejection of a bid will be announced immediately on the stroke of the hammer.

6. The base price mentioned in the list is minimum reserved price. Bidding below the minimum reserved price will not be accepted.

7. The bidder should check the animal for all aspects before bidding on the same day only (one person per party and one person at a time). No complaints will be entertained once the bidding formalities are over.

8. The highest bidder will have to deposit the whole amount by cash, RTGS, POS, swipe machine available with the cashier on the same day of bidding failing which the bid security will be forfeited. UTR No/Deposit slip towards deposit of the bid amount should be

submitted to the farm in-charge to obtain the delivery of the cow(s). However, security money will be refunded to non successful bidders within a week.

9. The purchaser will have to lift the animal(s) from the farm within the next three days of successful bidding. In case he/she fails to do so, management and feeding cost of Rs. 130/day per animal will be charged. The Institute will not be responsible for illness or death of the animals after deposit of bid value by the successful bidder.

10. The successful bidder shall have to make their own arrangement for lifting of the animals and in no case, auctioned animals will be allowed to keep in the farm for more than 7 days failing which the Institute will be free to dispose off the animals suitably.

11. The bidders should take precautionary measures for the safety of the workers while lifting/transporting the animal(s).

12. If any bidder does not follow the instructions of the ICAR RC for NEH Region, Nagaland Centre officials or create any type of nuisance, the same will be disallowed to participate in the bidding and can be asked to leave the venue immediately. Or legal actions can be taken against him/them as deemed fit by the office.

13. The animals once accepted for sale shall not be taken back or exchanged.

14. Bidder has to arrange all necessary permits for transporting the animals at his own cost including payment of other charges etc., if applicable.

15. Successful bidder has to lift the live animals from the farm and slaughtering of the pig will not be allowed in any case in the farm or within 100 meters of the farm boundary

16. The Joint Director of the Institute reserves the right to reject or accept any or all bids without assigning any reason whatsoever.
